



ADMISSION APPLICATIONS CHECKLIST

A complete application to Compass High School consists of the following:

- ✓ A completed admissions application form
- ✓ An application fee of \$150
- ✓ A letter of introduction in which the student's interests, talents, and current academic challenges are discussed. A letter from the student is optional.
- ✓ Recently administered (within three years) individual ability and achievement testing (e.g. WISC IV, WJ III, WIAT III)
- ✓ School records (e.g. recent report card). For transfer students, high school transcripts are required.
- ✓ Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or 504 plan if available
- ✓ Speech/Language, Occupational Therapy testing and other additional information that would enhance our understanding of the student, if available.
- ✓ A recent photo
- ✓ Financial aid information if a scholarship is needed

The admissions process at Compass High School involves careful analysis and consideration of each applicant's information. The goal is to ensure that there is a good fit between Compass High School and the student. To ensure that we can make accurate admissions decisions, a complete application must be submitted. For this reason, please note that only a complete application will be reviewed.
